SEATTLE: July 31, 2010 – The Circus of Dreams Guild is excited to announce our third annual event. Fresh home from the Vegas auditions for the TV show, America's Got Talent, our own Guild President (and Sky Siren) Jenn Wrenn has some new friends who will be joining the lineup of top talent from the Pacific Northwest for performances at ACT Theatre on October 8th, 9th, and 10th, 2010.

This year we'll also be giving fresh new talent a chance to spread their wings in the All-Star Student Sideshow co-produced by Versatile Arts. SANCA (School of Acrobatics and New Circus Arts) will host two Children's Matinees to delight the young ones. Then, we're pulling out all the stops for our Evening Benefit Show, co-produced by Tamara the Trapeze Lady. Inspired to use their talent to help better the world, all artists have graciously donated their performances.

Over the last two years, we've successfully raised and donated over \$65,000 to benefit the groundbreaking pediatric brain tumor research being led by Dr. Jim Olsen and his team in association with Seattle Children's Hospital. Brain tumors are the second most common type of childhood cancer. Less than 3% of cancer research is specific to pediatric cancer and only a small percentage of that funding goes toward brain tumor research.

We also promise an afternoon of joy and laughter to our special guests- children fighting serious illnesses. Sponsor donations cover the cost of tickets and parking, so the kids and their families can attend the show free of charge. Special passes will also allow them backstage for a meet and greet with the performers after the show plus small gifts from the Circus of Dreams Guild. Last year we were able to give a special day to 100 Make A Wish kids and family members.

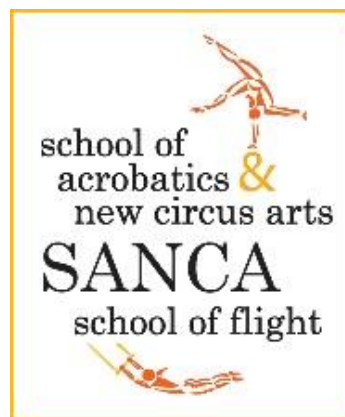
